

### IV3000 10cm x 12cm Suitable for dressing central line catheters

#### Step A



Clean and thoroughly dry the application area.

First remove section **1** from the end of the dressing. This contains 2 strips and a date label.

#### Step D



Using the tab gently peel off the top carrier marked **4**.

#### Step B



The strips can be used on the catheter wings or body for improved security, to secure tubing or to stabilise catheter lumens.

Peel off the backing paper marked **2**.

#### Step E



Mould the film around the catheter, ensuring the dressing is secure and the patient is comfortable.

Finally place the date label from section **1** on the skin or the dressing (without obscuring the view of the catheter site).



# Removal

Take one corner of the film and gently pull parallel to the skin (stabilising the patient's skin and catheter with the other hand).

### Step C



Centre the dressing over the catheter insertion site.

Place the dressing on the catheter hub and adhere the dressing to the patients skin.

Remove the remaining protector paper marked **3**.



Release and repeat the process.

# Suitable for PICC and midline catheters

Application with a stabilisation device

#### Step A



Clean and thoroughly dry the application area. First remove section 1 from the rounded end of the dressing. This contains 2 strips and a date label.

#### Step B



Peel off the backing paper marked **2** 

#### Step C

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Moisture Responsive Catheter Dressing

IV3000\*



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Place the dressing over the cannula site, ensuring that the entry site is as close to the centre of the dressing (clear section) as possible.

#### Step D



Arrange the ported area around the lumen and remove the backing papers marked **3** from the non-woven wings.

#### Step E



Using the tab gently peel off the top carrier marked 4.

Mould the film around the catheter, ensuring that the dresing is secure and the patient is comfortable.

#### Step F



The securing strips from section **1** can be used on the catheter for improved security to secure tubing or to stabilise catheter lumens. Finally place the date label from section **1** on the skin or the dressing (without obscuring the view of the catheter site).



# Removal

Gently peel back the non-woven wings to the point at which they reach the film section (stabilising the patient's skin and catheter with the other hand).

Take one corner of the film and gently pull

parallel to the skin.

Release and repeat the process.

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## IV3000 Ported 5cm x 6cm Suitable for dressing paediatric catheters

#### Step A



Clean and thoroughly dry the application area.

First remove section **1** from the rounded end of the dressing.

This contains 2 strips and a date label.

#### Step D



Position the dressing over the catheter port. Remove the backing papers marked 3 from the non woven sections and adhere over the catheter wings. Using the tab gently peel off the top carrier marked 4.



#### Step B



The strips can be used on the catheter wings or body for improved security, to secure tubing or to stablise catheter lumens.

#### Step C



Remove the backing paper marked 2.

#### Step E



Mould the film around the catheter, ensuring that the dressing is secure and the patient is comfortable.

Finally place the date label from section 1 on the skin or the dressing (without obscuring the view of the catheter site).

# Removal

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# IV3000 6cm x 7cm Suitable for dressing peripheral catheters



#### Step A



Clean and thoroughly dry the application area. First remove section **1** from the rounded end of the dressing. This contains 2 strips and a date label.

#### Step D

#### Step B



The strips can be used on the catheter wings or body for improved security, to secure tubing or to stablise catheter lumens.

Remove the backing paper marked **2**.

#### Step C



Centre the dressing over the catheter insertion site.

Place the dressing on the catheter port and adhere the dressing to the patients skin.

Remove the remaining protector paper marked **3**.



Using the tab gently peel off the top carrier marked  $(\mathbf{4})$ .

Mould the film around the catheter to complete dressing application.

Finally place the date label from section **1** on the skin or the dressing (without obscuring the view of the catheter site).



#### Removal

Take one corner of the film and gently pull parallel to the skin. Release and repeat the process.

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IV3000 Ported 7cm x 9cm

#### Suitable for dressing peripheral catheters

#### Step A



Clean and thoroughly dry the application area. First remove section **1** from the rounded end of the dressing.

This contains 2 strips and a date label.

#### Step B



The strips can be used on the catheter wings or body for improved security, to secure tubing or to stablise catheter lumens.

Remove the backing paper marked 2.

### Step C



Position the dressing over the catheter port. Remove the backing papers marked 3 from the non woven sections and adhere over the catheter wings.

#### Step D



Using the tab, gently peel off the top carrier marked 4

### Step E



Mould the film around the catheter, ensuring that the dressing is secure and the patient is comfortable.

Finally place the date label from section **1** on the skin or the dressing (without obscuring the view of the catheter site).



# Removal

Gently peel back the non-woven wings to the point at which they reach the film section (stabilising the patient's skin and catheter with the other hand).

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### IV3000 Ported 9cm x 12cm Suitable for dressing jugular and central line catheters

#### Step A



Clean and thoroughly dry the application area. First remove section 1 from the rounded end of the dressing.

This contains 2 strips and a date label.

#### Step B



The strips can be used on the catheter wings or body for improved security, to secure tubing or to stabilise catheter lumens.

Peel off the backing paper marked **2** Place the dressing over the cannula site, ensuring that the entry site is as close to the centre of the dressing (clear section) as possible.

#### Step C



Arrange the ported area around the lumen and remove the backing papers marked **3** from the non-woven wings.

The non-woven wings can be gently pulled together and overlapped to ensure the weight of the lumen is well secured.

#### Step D



Peel off the top film carrier marked **4** using the tab at the base of the dressing, pulling gently towards the direction of the port.

#### Step E



Mould the film around the catheter, ensuring that the dressing is secure and the patient is comfortable.

Finally place the date label from section **1** on the skin or the dressing (without obscuring the view of the catheter site).



# Removal

Gently peel back the non-woven wings to the point at which they reach the film section (stabilising the patient's skin and catheter with the other hand). Then take one corner of the film and gently pull parallel to the skin.



Release and repeat process.
